### **MS-4 Storm Sewer Report**

Permit was sent on March 9, 2023 and approved by the DNR on March 15, 2023. This is a new cycle of reporting and took a lot of extra time. The permit changes every 5 years.

### **STH 33 – Proposed Road Diet Project 2027**

The state showed proposed plans for the 2027 HWY 33 changes from Foster St in Port Washington. The state is proposing elimination a lane from the Northwoods round a bout all the way into Port Washington and the 2<sup>nd</sup> land would be turned into a bike lane. City of Port Washington and the Town of Port Washington are strongly opposed to these changes.

### **2023 Projects/Equipment Update**

**Stoney Ridge Way** – Sidewalk, curb and some driveway approaches have been marked for removal with minor assessments. DPW is going to stay ahead of the project and remove multiple trees causing problems and stump grind. Utility is replacing 2 fire hydrants ahead of the project as well.

**New Street Cleaner** – Will be delivered in August. The company is still dealing with shortages, the truck is 80% built at the current time.

**Library Patio Project**- The patio was poured and the furniture was installed. The charging station was damaged on delivery so we are waiting for a replacement. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Solar bench footings and pad will be getting poured the week of May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

**Community Message Board** – Had been installed April 10<sup>th</sup>. The DPW trenched in the wiring. The sign is working great. The old message board at Grady Park will be taken down in the next 2-3 weeks.
