The meeting was called to order at 4:30 p.m. by Jesse Duckart

Statement of Public Notice was given by Dawn Wagner, Village Administrator.

SEWER UPDATE

Hartmann talked about the Facilities plan for Biosolids

- The Facilities Plan covering Dewatering and Dryers should be completed by late fall.
- The New WWTP Discharge Permit will take effect in September.
 - Future PFAS Testing is required with the New Permit.
- The Knollwood Street and Whitegate Street Project will start the week of May 27, 2025. Sewer laterals will be slipped lined in the project.

2024 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR)

Hartmann reviewed the CMAR.

The CMAR gave the WWTP/Utility an A - 4.0 rating. No action is needed at this time.

Smith/Rudolph made a recommendation to the Village Board the approval of the 2024 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMAR). Motion Carried.

WATER SYSTEMS UPDATES

Kropidowski stated the Water Department continues to sample the water distribution system for PFAS per the DNR requirements. All the results are posted on the Village website. The Water Department is looking into future options for treatment.

Kropidowski added Well #1 (Grady Park) was repaired. A new pump and column pipe was installed. Estimated cost is \$55,000. Last rehabbed in 2018.

In Fall, the Water Department will have divers dive the standpipe and water tower to check for any deficiencies and vacuum out sediment that has settled in the tanks.

The Water Department is in the process of changing out Water Meters.

WATER MAIN LOOP PROJECT

Kropidowski stated the Village met with Eric Von Schledorn regarding the Village obtaining an easement through his property. Kropidowski added Eric Von Schledorn is very receptive to the idea. Ruekert and Mielke is currently working on the design. This project will be funded with the 2027 Borrowing.
