Stoney Ridge Way – Storm sewer crew is working this week to replace all the storm inlets and 30 ft of pipe. They have about 3 days' worth of work and then the project is ready for final pave the week of the 18th. DPW will be responsible for all restoration to save money on the project cost.

New Street Cleaner – Should be delivered in October/November. Chassis is in and they are currently waiting on several parts to complete the build.

Wagner informed the Committee that the Village Garbage and Recycling Contract expires at the end of 2023. The Village is soliciting for bids/proposals.


