“HOW TO” GUIDELINES

MATERIALS TO BE COMMINGLED	WHAT <u>CAN</u> BE RECYCLED?	CLEANING & PREPARATIONS	WHAT <u>CAN'T</u> BE RECYCLED?
Glass	Bottles and Jars ONLY Green, Clear, Brown	RINSE, CLEAN optional	Windows, Mirrors, Light Bulbs and Tubes, Pyrex and Dishes, Drinking Glasses, Chemical Bottles, Medical Containers, Laboratory Glass
Aluminum	Cans ONLY	RINSE, CLEAN, Flattening optional	Foil, Bottle Caps, Baking Pans
Tin & Steel Cans	Food Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans	RINSE, CLEAN, Flattening optional	Cardboard Sides/Juice Cans, Paint Cans,
Plastic	Milk, Soda, Detergent Bottles marked #1 PETE through #7	RINSE, CLEAN optional	Shrink Wrap, Plastic Toys, Medicine Bottles & Syringes, motor oil bottles
Paper And Cardboard	Newspapers, Magazines, Phone Books, Office Paper, Envelopes, Junk Mail, Brown Paper Tape, Computer Printouts, Manila File Folders, Glued Pads, Tablets, Corrugated Cardboard or Paperboard including cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons.		Bathroom Waste Paper (towels, toilet paper), Wrapping Paper, Carbon Paper, Candy Wrappers, Paper Cups & Plates, Napkins, Anything Waxed, Photographs, Fiberboard, Labels and Label Backings.

RECYCLING RULES:

- ❖ Place all permitted recyclables in the recycling cart (yellow top). No need to separate.
- ❖ **Recycling will be every other Thursday** (Friday if a holiday falls earlier in the week). See schedule on Village website: www.village.saukville.wi.us.
- ❖ **Place cart curbside by 7:00 a.m. on collection day.** Keep 3 feet distance between the cart and other obstacles, including trash cart.
- ❖ All non-recyclable, solid waste materials shall be placed in the trash cart.
- ❖ Hazardous waste must not be placed in carts. Take to the Ozaukee Co. Hazardous Waste Site at 1275 Mineral Springs Drive, Port Washington – Mondays only, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Ph: 800-243-8998
- ❖ Electronic devices must not be placed in the carts. These include, but are not limited to: computers, printers, monitors, computer accessories, TVs, DVD players, VCRs, DVRs, fax machines, cell phones. They must be taken to an electronic recycling facility. Other Options: Ozaukee Co. Hazardous Waste Site (disposal fees apply) or Ozaukee Iron & Metal (262-284-4060). Call for fees and information.
